We wish to inform you that the Board of Directors of the Company, at its meeting concluded today, inter alia, has approved the following:

- a) Audited Standalone and Consolidated Financial Results for the quarter and the year ended March 31, 2020;
- b) Audited Standalone and Consolidated Financial Statements for the year ended March 31, 2020;
- c) Recommended final dividend @ Re. 1/- per equity share of Rs. 2/- each (50%), for the year ended March 31, 2020, subject to the declaration of the same by the members at the ensuing Annual General Meeting. The dividend, if declared by the members, will be paid within the statutory timelines;
- d) Allotment of 3,48,945 equity shares of face value of Rs. 2/- each to the Eligible Employees of the Company, who have exercised their stock options under the "Special Purpose Birlasoft Employee Stock Option Plan 2019". These shares shall rank *pari-passu* with the existing equity shares of the Company in all respects. With this allotment, the paid-up capital of the Company has increased to Rs. 55,41,15,044/- divided into 27,70,57,522 equity shares of face value of Rs. 2/- each;
- e) Upon the recommendation of the Nomination & Remuneration Committee, the Board of Directors of the Company has, subject to the approval of the members of the Company in the ensuing Annual General Meeting, approved the waiver of recovery of excess remuneration paid to Mr. Anjan Lahiri former Managing Director & CEO of the Company, during the financial year 2019-20, on account of perquisite value of the equity shares under the Special Purpose Birlasoft Employee Stock Option Plan 2019 ("ESOP-2019"), vested in and exercised by him, which has resulted in his overall managerial remuneration exceeding the maximum remuneration permissible under the Companies Act, 2013. The managerial remuneration excluding the perquisite value of ESOP-2019 shares would have fallen well within the prescribed limits;





f) As intimated by the letter dated May 19, 2020, the requests received from certain shareholders of the Promoter & Promoter Group for re-classification to Public category, have been considered and approved, the updates on which are being sent separately.

Audited Standalone and Consolidated Financial Results for the quarter and the year ended March 31, 2020, along with Auditor's Reports thereon and investor update are being sent separately.

Further, pursuant to the relaxation provided by Securities and Exchange Board of India vide its circular dated May 12, 2020, for publishing the financial results in the newspaper under Regulation 47 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, and on account of the lock-down restrictions imposed by the Government of India, the Company will not be publishing the same for this quarter.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing ("SAs") specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act"). Our responsibilities under those SAs are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Consolidated Annual Financial Results* section of our report. We are independent of the Group in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements under the provisions of the Act, and the Rules thereunder, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence obtained by us is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion on the consolidated annual financial results.

Emphasis of Matter

We draw attention to note 11 to the consolidated financial results for the year ended 31 March 2020, relating to the Managerial Remuneration paid/accrued by the Holding Company for the year then ended which exceeds the limits prescribed under section 197 of the Companies Act, 2013 by INR 47.30 million and hence, is subject to approval of the shareholders in the General Meeting.

Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Management's and Board of Directors' Responsibilities for the Consolidated Annual Financial Results

These consolidated annual financial results have been prepared on the basis of the consolidated annual financial statements.

The Holding Company's Management and the Board of Directors are responsible for the preparation and presentation of these consolidated annual financial results that give a true and fair view of the consolidated net profit/ loss and other comprehensive income and other financial information of the Group in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Act and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations. The respective Board of Directors of the companies included in the Group are responsible for maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act; for safeguarding of the assets of each company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and the design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the consolidated annual financial results that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, which have been used for the purpose of preparation of the consolidated annual financial results by the Management and the Directors of the Holding Company, as aforesaid.

In preparing the consolidated annual financial results, the Management and the respective Board of Directors of the companies included in the Group are responsible for assessing the ability of each company to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the respective Board of Directors either intends to liquidate the company or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these consolidated annual financial result.

As part of an audit in accordance with SAs, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

We also performed procedures in accordance with the circular No CIR/CFD/CMD1/44/2019 issued by the SEBI under Regulation 33(8) of the Listing Regulations, as amended, to the extent applicable.

Other Matters

The consolidated annual financial results include the unaudited financial results of two subsidiaries, whose financial information reflect total assets (before consolidation adjustments) of Rs. 990.95 million as at 31 March 2020, total revenue (before consolidation adjustments) of Rs. 1,427.31 million and total net loss after tax (before consolidation adjustments) of Rs. 2.09 million, and net cash inflows of Rs. 340.89 million for the year ended on that date, as considered in the consolidated annual financial results. These unaudited financial information have been furnished to us by the Board of Directors and our opinion on the consolidated annual financial results, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries is based solely on such annual financial information. In our opinion and according to the information and explanations given to us by the Board of Directors, these financial information are not material to the Group.

Our opinion on the consolidated annual financial results is not modified in respect of the above matters with respect to our reliance on the work done and the financial information certified by the Board of Directors.

The consolidated annual financial results include the results for the quarter ended 31 March 2020 being the balancing figure between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published audited year to date figures up to the third quarter of the current financial year which were subject to limited review by us.

These audited consolidated financial results have been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards ("Ind-AS") as specified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with Rule 3 of the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 and the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Amendment Rules, 2016 and provisions of the Companies Act, 2013.
- 2 The Statutory Auditors of the Company have audited the above consolidated financial results of the Company for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2020. An unqualified opinion has been issued by them thereon.

- The results for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2020 are available on the Company's website, www.birlasoft.com and also on the website of the BSE Limited, www.bseindia.com and National Stock Exchange of India Limited, www.nseindia.com, where the shares of the Company are listed.
- The Group had adopted Ind AS 116, effective annual reporting period beginning April 01, 2019 and applied the standard to its leases using the modified retrospective approach as per para C5(b) of the standard. Accordingly, the Group recorded lease liability at present value of future lease payments discounted at the incremental borrowing rate and corresponding right-of-use asset at an amount equal to lease liability adjusted by the amount of any prepaid or accrued lease payments relating to that lease recognised in the balance sheet immediately before the date of initial application. Accordingly, the Group has not restated comparative information.

This had resulted in recognising right-of-use asset of ₹ 1,516.57 million and corresponding lease liability of ₹ 1,505.32 million as at April 01, 2019, after adjusting advance rent of ₹ 26.78 million and lease equalization reserve of ₹ 69.93 million, available as at March 31, 2019, against the right-of-use asset. In the statement of profit and loss for the year ended March 31, 2020, the nature of expenses in respect of operating leases has changed from lease rent in previous periods to depreciation cost for the right-of-use assets and finance cost for interest accrued on lease liabilities. In respect of lease that were classified as finance lease under Ind AS 17, an amount of ₹ 54.33 million had been reclassified from Property, plant and equipment to right-of-use assets as at April 01, 2019.

- The Government of India, on September 20, 2019, vide the Taxation Laws (Amendment) Act 2019, inserted a new Section 115BAA in the Income Tax Act, 1961, which provides an option to the Company to pay income taxes at reduced tax rates as per the provisions/conditions defined in the said section. The Company had evaluated and expects to exercise the option of lower tax rate of 25.17% (inclusive of surcharge and cess) under Section 115BAA of the Income Tax Act, 1961 in a subsequent financial year. Accordingly, the Company has estimated the reversal of deferred tax asset/ liabilities, until the date of exercise of the option and subsequent to exercise of the option. The effect of this change has been recognized in tax expense for the year ended March 31, 2020 on an effective tax basis. This has resulted in an increase in deferred tax expense of ₹ 32.76 million for the quarter ended March 31, 2020 on account of remeasurement of deferred tax asset.

- 5 The Company had adopted Ind AS 116, effective annual reporting period beginning April 01, 2019 and applied the standard to its leases using the modified retrospective approach as per para CS(b) of the standard. Accordingly, the Company recorded lease liability at present value of future lease payments discounted at the incremental borrowing rate and corresponding right-of-use asset at an amount equal to lease liability adjusted by the amount of any prepaid or accrued lease payments relating to that lease recognised in the balance sheet immediately before the date of initial application. Accordingly, the Company has not restated comparative information.

This had resulted in recognising right-of-use asset of ₹ 1,275.77 million and corresponding lease liability of ₹ 1,262.66 million as at April 01, 2019, after adjusting advance rent of ₹ 25.13 million, available as at March 31, 2019, against the right-of-use asset. In the statement of profit and loss for the year ended March 31, 2020, the nature of expenses in respect of operating leases has changed from lease rent in previous periods to depreciation cost for the right-of-use assets and finance cost for interest accrued on lease liabilities. In respect of lease that were classified as finance lease under Ind AS 17, an amount of ₹ 54.33 million has been reclassified from Property, plant and equipment to right-of-use assets as at April 01, 2019.

- 6 The Government of India, on September 20, 2019, vide the Taxation Laws (Amendment) Act 2019, inserted a new Section 115BAA in the Income Tax Act, 1961, which provides an option to the Company to pay income taxes at reduced tax rates as per the provisions/conditions defined in the said section. The Company had evaluated and expects to exercise the option of lower tax rate of 25.17% (inclusive of surcharge and cess) under Section 115BAA of the Income Tax Act, 1961 in a subsequent financial year. Accordingly, the Company has estimated the reversal of deferred tax asset/ liabilities, until the date of exercise of the option and subsequent to exercise of the option. The effect of this change has been recognized in tax expense for the year ended March 31 2020 on an effective tax basis. This has resulted in an increase in deferred tax expense of ₹ 32.76 million for the quarter ended March 31, 2020 and ₹ 100.50 million for the year ended March 31, 2020 on account of remeasurement of deferred tax asset.

- 9 Pursuant to his resignation, Mr. Rajeev Gupta Chief Financial Officer of the Company, was relieved from the service of the Company, effective March 31, 2020. The Company is in the process of appointing a new Chief Financial Officer.
- 10 The remuneration paid by the Company to its directors including managing and whole time directors, during the current year is in accordance with the provisions of Section 197 of the Companies Act 2013 ("the Act"), except to the extent it relates to the value of perquisites in the form of Employee Stock Options exercised by the former Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer of the Company which has resulted in the remuneration being excess by INR 47.31 million vis-a-vis the limits prescribed by the Act. The Company is in the process of obtaining approval from its members a the forthcoming Annual General Meeting for the same in accordance with the requirements of the Act.

However, the actual impact of COVID-19 on the Company's financial statements may differ from that estimated and the Company will continuous to closely monitor any material changes to future economic conditions.
